### **TOUR ITINERARY:**

### DAY 01 DEPART FROM CANADA

Board your flight to India. Dinner onboard aircraft.

### DAY 02 ARRIVE DELHI

On arrival in Delhi: traditional welcome at airport with garlands. Later transfer to hotel. Overnight at hotel in New Delhi.

### DAY 03 DELHI - AGRA (B, D)

Following a lavish buffet breakfast at your hotel in Delhi, drive to Agra and check in at your hotel. Overnight in Agra.

**Optional Excursion:** Itmad-Ud-Daulah Tour – CAD \$25 per person In the afternoon, cross Yamuna River to visit Itmad ud Daula. The mausoleum was built by Queen Nur Jahan in 1622 in memory of her father. Many historians believe that this monument was Shah Jahan's inspiration for building the Taj and is often described as the "petite Taj."

### DAY 04 AGRA (B)

Sunrise visit to THE TAJ MAHAL, India's most fascinating masterpiece. This magnificent tomb is a living symbol of the monumental passion of Shahjehan for his queen Mumtaz. [Optional: Enjoy a memorable TONGA ride (horse carriage) up to the legendary Taj Mahal (Subject to availablity and direct payment]. Return to hotel for breakfast and later take optional tours.

**Optional Excursion:** Agra Fort Tour – CAD \$25 per person Visit the splendid Agra Fort, built by and inhabited by six successive generations of Mughal emperors. Though often eclipsed by the Taj Mahal, this sprawling fortress, more accurately described as a massive walled palatial city, is magnificent in its own right, and is now a UNESCO World Heritage site.

### DAY 05 AGRA - JAIPUR (B, D)

After breakfast drive to Jaipur, en-route visiting FATEHPUR SIKRI - Old Deserted town of Mughal Dynasty. Upon arrival enjoy a GEM-CUTTING & POLISHING demonstration. Jaipur is one of the world's most noted gem producers. Overnight stay at hotel in Jaipur.

### DAY 06 JAIPUR (B)

Morning visit to AMBAR PALACE of the Kuchchawa rulers. Enjoy a ride on elephant-back (subject to availability) like the Maharajas Fort. Afternoon half-day optional tour of the PINK CITY. Overnight stay at hotel in Jaipur.

Optional Excursion: Pink City Tour - CAD \$30 per person Explore some of the city's famous pink sandstone buildings, including the CITY PALACE MUSEUM, housing the magnificent art collections of the Maharajas of Jaipur. At the entrance to the City Palace is JANTAR MANTAR, the largest of five observatories founded by classical astronomer Sawai Jai Singh II nearly three centuries ago. End your day with a visit to BIRLA TEMPLE.

### **DAY 07 JAIPUR – DELHI** (B)

After breakfast transfer to Delhi. Upon arrival in Delhi, check in to hotel. Evening at leisure. Overnight stay at hotel in Delhi.

### DAY 08 DELHI - DUBAI (B)

Morning sightseeing of Old Delhi, the Mughal capital established by Shah Jahan in 1638. At the famous Red Fort, where Jawaharlal Nehru unfurled the flag of newly-independent India on August 15, 1947, trade the vehicle for bicycle rickshaws. Weave through the warren of crooked, congested alleys off CHANDNI CHOWK, one of India's oldest and busiest bazaars, where you will see the traditional workmanship. Visit RAJ GHAT, Mahatma Gandhi's serene and evocative cremation site and the JAMA MASJID, one of the largest mosques in India. Drive past the BIRLA TEMPLE. Return to your hotel for check out.

Drive past the BAHAI (Lotus) temple and INDIA GATE (the war memorial), PARLIAMENT HOUSE and the PRESIDENT'S HOUSE. Later visit QUTUB MINAR, the victory tower started by Qutub-Ud-Din in 1199 AD upon becoming Sultan of Delhi. Evening transfer to the airport for flight for Dubai. Overnight at hotel in Dubai.

### **DAY 09 DUBAI (B, D)**

Your morning Dubai city tour with its ancient and traditional Arabian culture and heritage mixed with the modern cosmopolitan lifestyle will give you a fascinating historical excursion and orientation of the city. First we pass the beautiful flamingo lagoon. Our route takes us to Nad Al Sheba - the famous camel & horse race track. We will visit the new falcon market. We drive through Jumeirah until we reach the magnificent Jumeirah Mosque, showing the beauty of Islamic architecture (the mosque can only be visited Tuesday, Thursday & Sunday at 10:00 am with a reservation). In the Bastakiya area, we stop to admire the old wind-tower houses built by wealthy merchants. Close by is the 150-years old Al Fahidi Fort, which now houses the Dubai Museum. The museum records the city's past as an important pearl diving and trading centre. We continue our journey by Abra - a local water taxi which has survived the city's modernization over the centuries and brings us the spice and gold souk.

This evening, enjoy a Dhow Dinner Cruise. Lined with dhows, the Dubai Creek offers a picturesque glimpse of Dubai's trading heritage. You will have a chance to see the traditional abras (water taxis), which provide economical transport across the Creek for local residents. You will also have an excellent view of the Heritage and Diving Villages, and the Sheikh Saeed Al Maktoum House, a national monument that showcases the history and development of Dubai. Overnight at your hotel in Dubai.

### DAY 10 DUBAI (B, D)

Enjoy this morning at leisure or join the optional tour below.

This afternoon travel in luxury 4x4 vehicles through the desert. Experience the Arabian and Bedouin way of life in the desert. We will travel in the desert enjoying thrilling roller-coaster rides on the sand dunes and watch the beautiful sunset before arriving at your "BEDOUIN VILLAGE camp," a place that is practically in the middle of nowhere. Take a short camel ride, sit around the fire, dress in traditional Bedouin robes, sip the aromatic Arabic coffee or tea and try the hubbly-bubbly, henna painting and a fortune teller, experience sand surfing, or just simply laze on the pillows with a Shi Sha.

Evening, a delicious BBQ dinner will be served with Middle Eastern specialties cooked on site including chicken, lamb, Shish Kebab, hummus, tabouli and many other famous Arabic dishes. Finish off your Arabic adventure with a belly dancer performing right after dinner. You are invited to join in the fun on the dance floor before winding up this evening adventure. Overnight at your hotel in Dubai.

**Optional Excursion**: Dubai Mall & Burk Khalifa Tour – CAD \$85 pp Explore Dubai Mall, one of the biggest malls in the Middle East and get a chance to climb up Burj Khalifa, the tallest building in the world.

### DAY 11 DUBAI – CANADA (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Today you will have enough time to explore Ski Dubai on your own before transferring to airport. Late check out before evening transfer to Dubai International Airport for your flight back home.
